### **SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS**

#### **Finances**

The Club bank balance stood at £23k.

#### **Awards**

Andy Murray was winner of the Les Brown trophy for 2019.

#### **Track and Field**

Athletes for the Inter-Area indoor challenge on 1 March have now been selected but there were many gaps, particularly in the field events.

#### **Road Races and Walks**

Permits for all the walks planned for 2020 have been applied for.

Robert Scott has accepted the club's single London Marathon place, following a ballot.

The Towpath 10 on 19 April will be used for VAC's 10 mile championship and the Ranelagh 10K on 21 June will be used for the club 10K. The next parkrun at Canon's Park, Edgware will take place on 22 February, a week later than originally scheduled. Lloyd parkrun will be used for the following event on 13 June.

The start for the Battersea Park series of 5 mile races will be moved to South Carriage Drive near the toilets past the end of the car park. The direction of the race will be changed to anti-clockwise.

#### **Cross country**

A new course to avoid the golf course will be used for future VAC cross country championships at the request of the Wimbledon Common conservators.
